Young Women in Public Affairs (YWPA) Award Fund

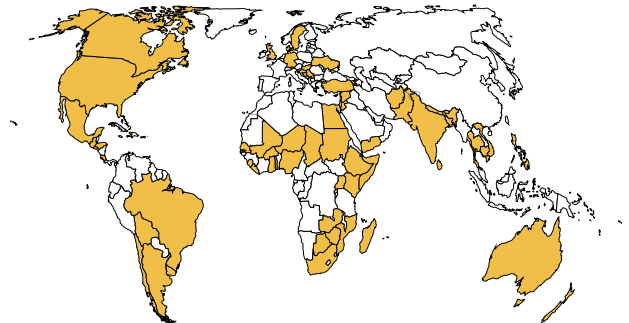
Zonta gives district/region and international awards to honor women aged 16 to 19 who demonstrate leadership skills and a commitment to public service and civic causes.

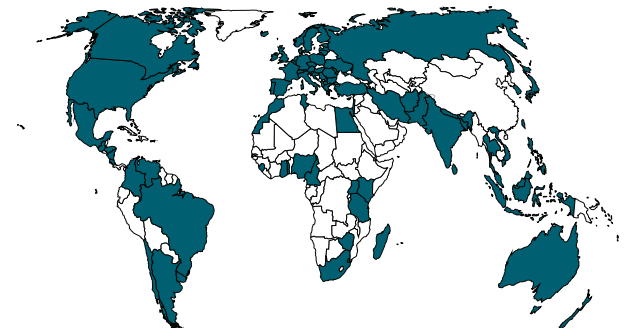
