Dr. Koski's current research focuses on child marriage as a public health and development issue. She will discuss Canadian laws regarding child marriage and how many children have been married across the country over the past twenty years.

In partnership with UNFPA and UNICEF, Zonta International launched Ending Child Marriage: A Program to Accelerate Global Action. Despite laws against it, 21% of girls are married before they turn 18, robbing them of their childhood, and frequently affecting their physical and mental health..
